Abstract Submission:

Full papers will be accepted for publication in the proceedings. Presenters agree to register for the symposium.

Workshop Proposal Submission:

Submit a 1-2 page workshop outline that includes information on the subject matter and name(s), affiliation(s), email address, and phone number of workshop instructors

Deadlines:

1. Submission of Abstracts and Workshop Proposals
2. Notification of Acceptance/Rejection
3. Papers for publication in the proceedings
